
RotoBed® aims to deliver the world's most helpful beds. A RotoBed® offers less pain, longer mobility, more dignity, and an increased quality of life.

RotoBed®Change with fully automatic rotation





With a RotoBed®, people who have difficulty getting in and out of bed are now able to do so with no physical effort.

Just by a single touch of a remote control the bed is elevated to chair position and rotated towards the room.

This facilitates both exit and transition to a wheelchair or stand-aid.

Simple and comprehensive remote control.

Besides the rotating function also height, backrest and leg part are adjusted with the remote control.

The rotating mechanism is smooth, quiet and very comfortable for the user.

The patient surface is 4-sectioned and provides optimal support.

RotoBed®Classic...

RotoBed®Classic is a harmoniously designed functional bed with a built-in option to upgrade to a RotoBed®Change with rotation.

The RotoBed®Classic has electrical adjustment of backrest and leg-part to ensure comfortable positions in bed.

Furthermore, it has height adjustment. The bed base can be moved down to 32 cm above the

floor and up to 82 cm above the floor. This is very beneficial for people with pain or a limited mobility when getting in and out of bed.

If the user's needs change, the RotoBed®Classic can be upgraded with a rotational function, which turns it into a RotoBed®Change.

Exit height

RotoBed®Home is suitable for both tall and small users. By measuring your leg length from flat foot to the hollow of the knee, you will find the one of the four exit heights that best suits you. It is

possible to change the exit height afterwards by moving a few screws. The bed is also equipped with adjusting screws for fine tuning the exit height.

RotoBed®Home head- and footboards are available in two variants: The low variant is made of moulded metal covered with removable textiles or leather.

The high variant is form bended oak veneer combined with fixed textiles or leather. You choose; the different combinations each give their own expression.


Simple and comprehensive remote control

Adjusting height, backrest, leg-part and position during rotation is easy with the RotoBed® hand control.

User-friendliness is high, with only few and intelligible keys on the remote control. The two buttons "Chair Position" and "Sleeping Position" control the entire bed's rotation cycle.

With the hand control, is also possible to store remote control, your individual favorite settings for exit height, inclination of the backrest, as well as oblique or perpendicular exit.

NOTE: The RotoBed®Home model does not have height adjustment. Apart from this, the remote control is the same.



Wireless remote control in unique design

Exclusive and handy remote control. All buttons and functions can be operated with one hand, and navigation is simple and intuitive.

The display automatically adjusts the brightness to the surroundings. Time and date, flashlight and 6 optional languages.

The bed rotation cycle is controlled by holding a single key.

It is also possible to save individual favourite settings for backrest inclination as well as oblique or perpendicular exit.

Comes with specially designed leather case, attachable to the bedrail.

When our beds leave the production, it also happens on pallets and with packaging that is either recyclable or degradable.




RotoBed®Light Package – a bright solution

With a new and patented invention, users of a RotoBed® can get out of bed safely also during night. When the RotoBed® rotates towards the floor, two soft spotlights under the bed will turn on – as well an external lamp after your choice. Maybe you want it to be the lamp in your bathroom?

When the bed is rotated back into sleeping position, both the spotlights and the lamp go out. This unique light system is developed in cooperation with LINAK. The external lamp is simply connected to the system by a plug.





The 4 layers each have characteristics that increase flexibility and airflow, reducing the shear effect. Naturally produced without CFC and is CertiPur and Oekotex-100 certified.

RotoBed® RoHo® - Decubitus protection mattress

2-layer quality mattress custom-made for RotoBed® with proven decubitus protection and treatment in all stages. The air cells are made from soft and flexible neoprene. The linked cels provide a large contact surface and a constant low pressure on both the skin and the deeper tissues. The mattress requires no use of an electrical pump. This makes transfer easier and saves user and staff of unpleasant noise, vibration, and heat.

Recommended user weight 40 kg – 190 kg.



RotoBed®AirSleep - hybrid mattress

Decubitus, also known as pressure ulcers, can be very painful and require prolonged treatment and care. Pressure ulcers arise where the skin is close to the bones, for example on the back, hips and heel, and are caused by prolonged pressure against the skin and the tissues just below.

A healthy person changes position up to 30 times in one night, but unconscious, paralyzed or weakened people are unable to do so and will develop pressure ulcers if prevention is not initiated.


The best from 2 worlds

A hybrid mattress combines the pressure distribution properties of advanced foam mattresses with the periodic pressure relief as with alternating air mattresses.

Start by using RotoBed®AirSleep as a good pressuredistributing foam mattress with a high level of sleeping comfort. When the alternating function for periodic total relief of pressure against the skin is needed, just switch on the connected pump. When the alternating function is no longer needed, simply disconnect the pump, and the mattress again works as a comfortable pressure-distributing mattress.


The ability to switch between static and dynamic function limits expensive and time-consuming mattress changes. This makes the hybrid systems particularly suitable for use in patient's homes, palliative care environments and hospital wards with patients at risk of pressure ulcers.


